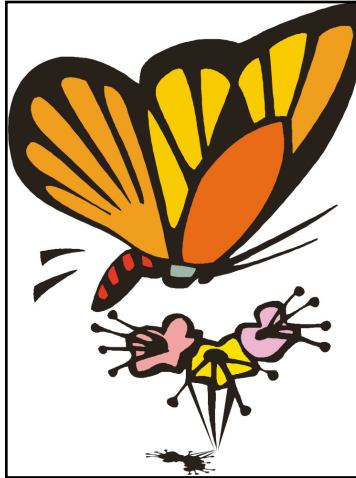
Current Events
